#### PRACTICAL NEXT STEPS:

- 1. Ponder your destination. What do you believe will happen when you die? Many simply don't care and so they live for immediate pleasure (Isa. 22:13, 1 Cor, 15:32). But, if Paul is correct and our god is our stomach (Phil. 3:19), then destruction is our destiny. If your stomach/desires determine most of your actions then you should be concerned. I urge you to find answers to your doubts, pray for God to give you understanding, and ultimately to repent of your being an enemy of the cross.
- 2. Prioritize knowing Jesus. Many of you have believed and confessed Jesus as your Lord and Savior at some point in life. This passage points us beyond a simple decision for salvation to a life-long pursuit of knowing Jesus. Would you say you have a healthy relationship with Jesus or a distant relationship? Will you prioritize thus relationship and commit to reading the Bible and prayer daily?
- 3. Press on toward maturity. When Paul wrote these words, he had been following Jesus for many years, yet he had not arrived. You are not done. You are not as mature as you think you are. You are not as wise as you perceive. You are not as holy as you should be. So, stretch yourself: join a small group, ask trusted believers about your blind spots, spend 3 hours on a prayer retreat, read a Pauline letter each day this week, or study a challenging book like *Kill the Spider, Discipleship Essential, Knowing Scripture, or Everyone's a Theologian*. Press on toward maturity!

## Search Team Update & Congregational Vote Announcement

This past weekend Tim Fennell (Candidate #2) was flown in from New York to meet with the Search Team in person. The review process set out by Slingshot was to start with the Search Team, then the Consistory, then the Staff, and once an agreed-upon recommendation was made, the Congregation. This was the first step in the process. (If he lived closer, the Search Team would have drove to meet him halfway. Due to scheduling conflicts on our side, the only available weekend was last weekend.) Tim had an opportunity to meet the Search Team over a meal on Saturday night, and then came to Sunday service. Since this fell on Jessa's going away service, we didn't want to take away from that special day for her, by announcing Tim's attendance. It also allowed Tim to experience a Sunday service without the distractions that would come if the focus were on him.

On Monday night, the Search Team met to discuss their conversations with Tim, and after discussion, were excited to make a recommendation to the Consistory.

On Tuesday night, the Consistory was presented the recommendation to hire Tim Fennell as the Equipping Young Adults and Families Director from the Search Team. (This position will start as a "Director" position while Tim continues his course work that is required to be ordained. Once ordained, his title will change to Equipping Young Adults and Families Pastor or something similar. It is anticipated that the remaining requirements will take another year to complete.) The Search Team presented this recommendation in person, including the non-Consistory members, to provide their reasons/support for the recommendation.

After discussion, a motion was passed by the Consistory to recommend to the Congregation to hire Tim Fennell as the Equipping Young Adults and Families Director. On Sunday, May 26<sup>th</sup>, a short video will be played during service to introduce Tim to the Congregation. The Search Team will be up front after service to answer any questions that the congregation might have about Tim and their time that they spent with him. The following week, Sunday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>, there will be a Congregational vote. Results will then be provided to the Consistory for the final vote.

We pray for continued wisdom on this decision.
